| <p><b>Training /<br/>Drills<br/>3</b></p> | <p><b>SCHOOL SAFETY &amp; SECURITY</b><br/> <b>Safety and Security Training:</b> One or more of the following: situational awareness, trauma-informed approaches, behavioral health awareness, suicide and bullying awareness, and substance use awareness. Training may be in-person or virtual.</p> <p><b>Emergency Preparedness Training:</b> Emergency training drills (including fire, natural disaster, active shooter, hostage situation, and bomb threat), and the identification or recognition of student behavior that may indicate a threat to the safety of the student, other students, school employees, other individuals, school facilities, or the community.
