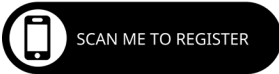


VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: PENN STATE FOCUS GROUP

Who Can Volunteer?

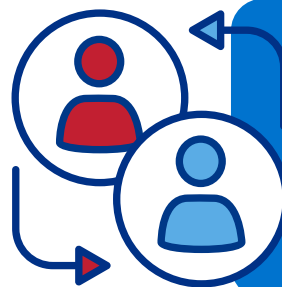
Youth, grades 9-12, are invited to participate.
